## **WHAT DO I NEED TO BRING?**

### 1. BEDDING

## **FISHING**

### **Fishing License:**

\*\*\*Please purchase your licenses online the week before we depart\*\*\*\*\*

This will save us time in purchasing them there. If you are unable to do so in advance, there will be opportunity to purchase them the first day of fishing.

**Please insure you purchase OUT OF STATE LICENSES.**

## **Fishing Gear:**

Bring your own pole and tackle. Any pole will work. There is a Walmart Supercenter just 30 minutes away that is well stocked with fishing gear if you choose to purchase gear there. We can arrange a trip to Walmart on the first day of fishing.

## **Where will we fish?**

There are very long Jetties as well as very long Piers that offer opportunities for Reds, Shark, and all kinds of sea life. Large crabs are an easy catch as well, so you might consider a crab license.

## **Can we go out on boats?**

If you would like to go out bay fishing it has been proven by locals to be better results than deep sea fishing in the area. There is a separate fee for this and it must be set up well in advance. Please notify us by October 5<sup>th</sup>, 2020, if you know you will want to schedule a boat. **IT DOES REQUIRE** that there is a boat full (5 to 6 men). It is \$100.00 per person collected by the boat captain / fishing guide. Deep Sea fishing in \$1,000.00 a boat and can only hold 5 to 6 men as well.

Your chances of a catch are greater in the bay instead of deep sea. Our host Pastor in Port O'Conner highly suggests the Pier and Jetty fishing, but if you want a boat, he suggests bay fishing.
